## SUMMARY OF STATE HIGHWAY RIGHT-OF-WAYS IN SENECA COUNTY

OHIO 231: 60' right-of-way from the south Section lines of Sections 7 & 8 in Eden Township north to the City of Tiffin Corporation Line. (Seneca County Commissioner's Journal on Roads) Vol. 37; Page 488 dated March 4, 1937.

OHIO 231: 40' right-of-way from the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 18 northerly to the south section lines of Section 7 & 8 Eden Township and also 40' right-of-way from the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 18 Eden Township south to where Honey Creek crosses said road. 60' right-of-way from where Honey Creek crosses said road south to Township Road 58 (Center Rd.) and south lines of Section 17 and 18 Eden Township. (Seneca County Road Record) Volume 5; Pages 108 thru 127 dated June 26, 1917.

- OHIO 4: Could not find any record of proceedings establishing this route thru Seneca County, believe this route was established by an Act of State Legislature and was opened at a width of 60' (NOTE OLD DRAWINGS ON FILE SHOW a 60' right-of-way).
- OHIO100: Originally established with a 60' right-of-way; was changed to a 40' right-of-way from Tiffin's South Corporation Line south to the base line (Seneca County Road 58) (Seneca County Road Record) Volume 5; Page 24 dated August 25, 1906.

RIGHT OF WAY VARIES FROM EXISTING CORP. LINE OF TIFFIN SOUTHEAST TO US 224. MOSTLY 80' R/W (See State of Ohio Right of Way Plans)

- OHIO 587: Established at a 66' right-of-way by action of County Commissioners; running from Fostoria southeasterly to the South Seneca County Line. Volume 37; Pages 480 and 488 Seneca County Commissioners Journal dated March 4, 1937.
- OHIO 635: Established at a 60' right-of-way by action of County Commissioners; running from Bascom or its intersection with Ohio 18 northerly to the north Seneca County Line. Volume 37; Pages 480 and 488 of the Seneca County Commissioners Journal dated March 4, 1937.

- ✓ OHIO 19: Establishes a portion of State Rt. 19 where Honey Creek crosses said State Rt. 19 in Section 10 of Bloom Township, thence northerly along State Rt. 19 a distance of six miles & 726 feet to a point on the Section line between Sections 3 & 4 in Scipio Township. (Seneca County Road Record) Volume 1; Page 9 dated July 28, 1824. 60' R/W =D. Risdon (Surveyor) based on date of establishment.
- √ OHIO 18: Establishes a portion of State Rt. 18 from Republic northeasterly to the north Seneca County Line (Seneca County Road Record) Volume 1; Pages 26 & 27 dated October 29,1821. 66' R/W
- OHIO 67: Establishes State Rt. 67 from the South Seneca County Line northeasterly to the Village of Republic, Ohio, Seneca County. (Seneca County Road Record) Volume 1; Pages 26 & 27 dated October 29, 1821. 66' R/W

Date of Establishment means that there was no specific R/W established & it was done by an Attorney General's opinion.
